A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, January 9, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, TX with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners: Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, Clerk; Mike Munk, Attorney; Judy Bush, Tax Collector/Assessor; and Ruth Ann Young, Treasurer.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Kathy Beach, Texas Plains Trail Region; and Rosa Latimer, The Garza Post.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the December 28, 2011 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Morris. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 2: The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written report or for discussion:
- a. Clerk
  - b. Senior Transportation
- Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Benham to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Reports are attached.)
- Order 3: Came on to be considered were the precinct and countywide accounts payable for December 29, 2011 through January 9, 2012. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham that all such accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out are allowed and ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)
- Order 4: Came on for consideration was to advertise for sealed bids for a 1980 John Deere 670A motor grader. The item is in the possession of Commissioner Precinct 4, Jerry Benham who submitted suggested wording for the classified advertisement. A motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to advertise for sealed bids for the motor grader for two weeks with bids due by 5:00 p.m. Jan. 20, 2012.

With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (The suggested wording for the ad is attached.)

Order 5: Came on for consideration was the selection of the Garza County Employee Grievance Committee.  
A motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner McDaniel to appoint the following people drawn at random from the outgoing Grand Jury members to the 2012 Grievance Committee: (1) Kenny Massie (2) Kristie Odom, (3) Victor Ashley, and (4) Kevin James. Also on the Grievance Committee are the county judge, clerk, treasurer, tax assessor and the sheriff. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 6: Came on for consideration were line item transfers and budget amendment requests.  
One (1) line item transfer was submitted.


a. A motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve the line item transfer presented for the sheriff's deputy office for \$500.

Judge Norman said that the elevator is installed and the finish work is underway.


Order 8: Public Comment


