Main Street, Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners: Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel, Pct. 2- Charles Morris; Pct. 3-Ted Brannon; and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present were Terry Morgan, Sheriff.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:04 a.m.

Sheriff Morgan informed the court that Dr. Chad Gray is willing to accept the contract for medical and related services at the jail. It was noted that Dr. Ben Edwards, who currently has the contract, no longer lives in the county.
Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the contract with Dr. Chad Gray to provide medical and related services at the Garza

County Jail. With a majority of the court members voting aye,
the motion carried and so ordered.
