

A special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Friday, September 21, 2012 at 9:00 A.M., at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, TX with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners: Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

Not present was Pct. 3 Commissioner Ted Brannon.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, Clerk; Judy Bush, Tax Collector / Assessor and Ruth Ann Young, Treasurer.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:04 P.M.

Order 1: Adopt 2012-2013 Budget

Came on for adoption was the Garza County 2012-2013 fiscal year budget.

A motion to adopt a balanced budget of \$7,864,464.00 for the 2012-2013 fiscal year was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner McDaniel.

With the vote being called for with three commissioners and the judge present, the court unanimously voted aye. The motion carried and was so ordered.

Order 2: Set 2012-2013 Tax Rate


Came on for adoption was the Garza County 2011-2012 fiscal year Tax Rate.

A motion for the adoption of a tax rate of .355 cents per \$100 valuation, a decrease in the tax rate from the previous year (.37809), was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner McDaniel. The .355 rate per \$100 valuation will generate \$3,442,428 in ad valorem tax revenue, \$2,926,063 of which is general fund, with the balance (\$516,365) split proportionately between the precincts.


With the vote being called for with three commissioners and the judge present, the court unanimously voted aye. The motion carried and was so ordered.

The next regular meeting of the court is set for Monday, September 24, 2012.


The meeting adjourned at 9:07 A.M.




GARY MCDANIEL, COMMISSIONER PCT. 1
