A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Wednesday, July 3, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, TX with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners – Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3- Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Preston Poole, Attorney; Nancy Wallace, Tax Collector/Assessor; and Terry Morgan, Sheriff. Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Christy Tadlock, Deputy Treasurer; and J.W. Payton.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the June 24, 2013 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.



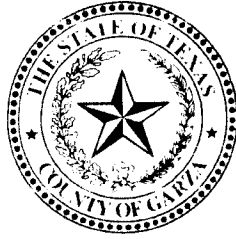
