A special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, April 6, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, TX with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners – Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Commissioner Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham. County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk and Ted Weems, Attorney; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector. Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Bobby Dean and Zara the drug detection dog; Kent Mahoney, Post Dispatch.

Prior to the meeting, Post ISP police officer Bobby Dean gave a demonstration of his drug detection dog Zara.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m.


- Order 2: Came on for consideration was a resolution to amend the Constitution of the State of Texas to allow counties, under 7,500 population, to work on private property for pay. Judge Norman said this resolution may affect 72 counties. Senator Charles Perry will sponsor the proposed amendment in the Senate and Representative Drew Springer will sponsor it in the House. Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Benham to support the Resolution to allow counties, under 7,500 population, to work on private property for pay. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Resolution is attached.)
- Order 1: Came on for consideration was the appointments to the Garza County Historical Commission Board. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham to appoint Linda Puckett, Nancy Thuett, Gary McDaniel, Pat Cruse, Kathy Fluitt, Judy Bush and Ruth Ann Young to the county historical commission board. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Information is attached.)

The meeting adjourned at 9:21 a.m.





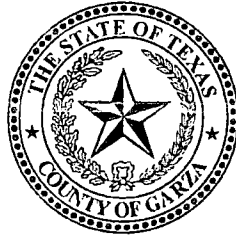
