

A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, April 27, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, TX with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners – ~~Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel~~, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham. *NOT PRESENT: Pct. 1 COYNE J. MCDANIEL*  
County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Keith Williams, Peoples Bank; and Kent Mahoney, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the April 13, 2015 regular meeting and the April 20, 2015 special meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:
- a. Clerk
  - b. County Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (March)
  - c. District Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (March)
  - d. Garza Wildlife Damage Association
  - e. Sheriff Morgan: presented the SPAG report and the jail billing report. He predicts that the April jail billing report will be down because the local inmate count is up.  
(Written reports are attached.)

Motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

- Order 3: Came on to be considered were the precinct and countywide accounts payable for April 14, 2015 through April 27, 2015. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)
- Order 4: Came on for consideration was an application for public assistance. Attorney Weems informed the court that the applicant qualifies under the guidelines. Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Benham to approve the application from R.L.: \$75 for electricity. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Application is attached.)
- Order 5: Came on for consideration were line item transfers and budget amendment requests. None presented.
- Order 6: Public Comment  
Keith Williams explained that Peoples Bank will bid on the county's depository contract. He also warned against debit card use due to fraud.  
Judge Norman reported that Lynn County has applied for a grant to start a regional psychiatric service.

The meeting adjourned at 9:14 a.m.


