**Lee Norman - Garza County Judge**

A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, June 22, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, TX with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners – Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham. County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Linda Puckett and Pat Cruse, Garza County Historical Museum; Kent Mahoney, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

Order 1: Minutes from the June 8, 2015 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:

- a. Clerk
- b. Tax Assessor/Collector
- c. Justice of the Peace – 2
- d. Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service – Jones
- e. Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service – McDonald
- f. Guardianship & Mental Cases– DPS (Jan, Feb & April)
- g. Garza Wildlife Damage Association
- h. Sheriff Morgan: presented billing report. Jail inspection is being conducted today.

Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 3: Came on to be considered were the precinct and countywide accounts payable for June 9, 2015 through June 22, 2015. Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Morris that all accounts presented in the fund

requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)

- Order 4: Came on before the court was a presentation from the Texas Historical Commission honoring the Garza County Historical Commission with the Distinguished Service Award for year 2014. Judge Norman presented the award to Linda Puckett who commented that this is the fourth year in a row for the local commission to receive the award.  
No action necessary.
- Order5: Came on for submission was the county commissioners' annual road reports.  
The reports from Precincts 1, 2, 3 and 4 were submitted.  
A motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to accept the annual road reports from all four precincts as presented.  
With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Reports are attached.)
- Order 6: Came on for consideration was a Department of Homeland Security request for public assistance: FEMA DR 4223 TX.  
A motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner McDaniel to request public assistance from FEMA.  
With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (The request and information are attached.)
- Order 7: Came on for consideration was a budget amendment request.  
A motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner McDaniel to approve the budget amendment for the juvenile probation office for \$9273.  
With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Request is attached.)
- Order 8: Came on for consideration were line item transfers and budget amendment requests.  
One (1) line item transfer was submitted.

a. A motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the line item transfer presented for the Constable 1 office for \$3000. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

The meeting adjourned at 9:18 a.m.



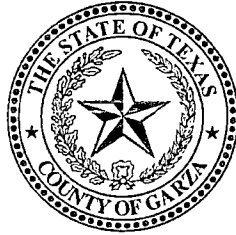
