

A special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Tuesday, September 8, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, TX with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham. Not present was Commissioner Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; Luann Terry, Treasurer; Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector; and Eric Cravy, Constable 2.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Marsha Norman; Bob Zivec; and Jayta Cravy.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Order 1: Public Hearing on the 2015-2016 Budget  
Came on before the court was the second of two public hearings concerning the proposed budget.

Judge Norman welcomed the guests.

Constable Eric Cravy informed the court that the changes in his budget at the last commissioners' court meeting was illegal according to the attorney representing him.

He urged the court to examine the records before making a final decision on his department's budget.

He offered the records for the court's review.

Judge Norman said that he is satisfied by the court's handling of the budget process. A grievance committee meeting was requested by Constable Cravy and is set for Friday, September 11, 2015 at 3:00 p.m.

Attorney Weems requested access to the evidence held by Constable Cravy's counsel (McWhorter Cobb and Johnson) in order to review the information and advise the court properly before any final action is taken. Cravy would see that the information be forward to Weems.

Judge Norman said that the proposed budget generates the same revenue and holds to an effective rate when compared to last year's approved budget.

He added that the reason for the shift in the tax burden to the property owner is due to the much lower mineral interest values.

No action taken.

The meeting adjourned at 5:42 p.m.

*The next regular meeting and the meeting to adopt the budget and set the tax rate, is Monday, September 14, 2015.*

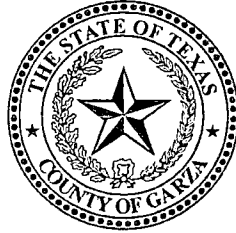
