A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, March 28, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners - Pct. 1-Gary McDaniel; Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; and Luanne Terry, Treasurer.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the March 14, 2016, regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Benham. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:
- a. Sheriff Morgan: Jamie Pewitt has resigned to move to the Arlington, TX area. A recent audit by TCIC audit was the best the department has received. The department is being sued for an accident during the transportation of inmates. TAC is involved on behalf of the county. Two of five new AC units are installed and operating at the law enforcement office.
 - b. Garza Wildlife Damage Services Program
- Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Benham to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 3: Came on for consideration was the precinct and countywide accounts payable for March 14, 2016 through March 28, 2016. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner McDaniel that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)
- Order 4: Came on for consideration was approval to sell surplus property. Sheriff Morgan said there is an online auction service that can sell the property and the service receives 5% of the sale price. Commissioners were advised to compile a list of items to be submitted for sale at the next meeting.

No action taken.

Order 5: Came on for consideration was approval for Judge Norman to serve on the West Texas Judges and Commissioners Board. Motion was made by Commissioner McDaniel and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to support Judge Norman in his effort to serve on the board. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 6: Came on for consideration was line item transfers and budget amendment requests. One (1) budget amendment was submitted.

a. A motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve the line item transfer presented for the sheriff's office for \$4459.22. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 7: Public Comment
None presented.


The meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.
