



A special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, November 21, 2016 at 11:00 a.m., at the Commissioners' Courtroom with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners:, Pct. 2- Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham. Not present was Pct. 1 Commissioner Gary McDaniel

Order 1: **Canvass the November 8, 2016 General Election**


