A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, April 24, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham. Not present was Pct 1 Commissioner Jeff Williams. County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; and Terry Morgan, Sheriff. Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; and Julia Childs, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.)

- Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:
- a. District Attorney Philip Mack Furlow: informed the court about disposed cases, indictments and schedule of major cases to be tried by July. Technology upgrades are underway and should improve workflow. He introduced first Assistant DA Kevin Henry.
 - b. Clerk Plummer: as per a memo from the Secretary of State, revised Certificates of Election and ID cards were redistributed to county officials who were elected in the November 2016 General Election.
 - c. Judge Norman: Hosted an area judges' meeting on Friday at the Heritage House with 12 judges.
 - d. Sheriff Morgan: TAC is coming to the law enforcement center Thursday and Friday to hold jail and peace officer training. Nine other counties may attend.
 - e. County Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration
 - f. District Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration
 - g. US Bank: Garza County Combination Tax and Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 2008 Bond, Reserve and Construction Funds Garza County Public Facility Corporation Taxable Project Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2012 Bond, Reserve and Project Funds; Rental, Operating, Surplus, Cost of Issuance, Escrow Accounts and Juvenile Facility Surplus Account.
- Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Benham to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Written reports are attached.)

- Order 1: Minutes from the April 10, 2017 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Benham and seconded by

Commissioner Brannon. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

- Order 3: Came on for consideration was the precinct and countywide accounts payable for April 11, 2017 through April 24, 2017. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)
- Order 4: Came on for consideration was Designation of an area for foreclosure sales. Clerk Plummer referred to 51.002(a) of the Texas Property Code and explained that this matter corrects and updates the Designation done in 1987. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the Designation and that it be recorded in the Official Public Records of the County Clerk. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Designation is attached.)
- Order 5: Came on for consideration was a bid for county property; Lot 3, Block 155, 105 E. 4th St., Post: Two (2) bids were submitted. Attorney Weems recommended accepting the bid from Sharla Osborne for \$1000. Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Benham to accept the bid from Osborn for \$1000. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Bid and information are attached.)
- Order 6: Came on for consideration was the Certification of Airport Property Interests. A motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the certification with the Texas Department of Transportation. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Certification and Information are attached.)
- Order 7: Came on for consideration was a proclamation/resolution for Child Abuse Prevention Month. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham to proclaim April 2017 Child Abuse Prevention Month in Garza County.

With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Proclamation/Resolution is attached.)

Order 8: Came on for consideration was line item transfers and budget amendment requests.

The next regular meeting is set for Monday, May 8, 2017.






JEFF WILLIAMS, COMMISSIONER PCT. 1
