A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, February 26, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct. 1-Jeff Williams, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct. 3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; and Terry Morgan, Sheriff.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Terri Laurence, Deputy Tax Assessor/Collector; J. Terry Bartlett, PEDC; and Julia Childs, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the February 12, 2018, regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Williams. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:
- a. Sheriff: Repair to the bridge on FM 651 is starting today. Repair to the bridge at Gobbler Creek at Lake Alan Henry was moved to September.
 - b. Clerk Plummer reported on the early voting turnout so far.
 - c. Treasurer
 - d. Budget Analysis Usage Report
 - e. Clerk
 - f. County Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (Dec & Jan)
 - g. District Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (Dec & Jan)
- Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Morris to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Written reports are attached.)
- Order 3: Came on for consideration was the precinct and countywide accounts payable for February 13, 2018 through February 26, 2018. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out including payroll estimates is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)

- Order 4: Came on for consideration was the agreement for the drug and alcohol program.
Judge Norman explained that agreement is with Allied Compliance, Inc. that performs the responsibility program that tests some county employees.
A motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Williams to approve the agreement.
With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Agreement is attached.)
- Order 5: Came on for consideration was line item corrections and budget amendment requests.
Two (2) budget amendments were submitted.
- a. A motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Benham to approve the budget amendment presented for the sheriff's office for \$2599.47.
With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- b. A motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Benham to approve the budget amendment presented for the constables' office for \$736.54.
With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

(None presented.)


The meeting adjourned at 9:07 a.m.






JEFF WILLIAMS, COMMISSIONER PCT. 1

TED BRANNON, COMMISSIONER PCT. 3



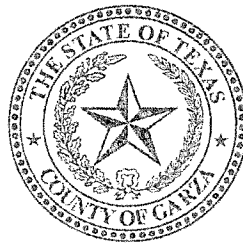
