A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Thursday, May 24, 2018 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct.1-Jeff Williams, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct.3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Collector/Assessor.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; J. Terry Bartlett, Garza County Healthcare District (GCHCD); Michael Isbell, Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC); and Julia Childs, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Order 4: Came on for consideration was the County multi-jurisdiction Hazardous Mitigation Plan.

Michael Isbell, (EMC) informed the court about the grant process and that it includes the City of Post, Post ISD and Southland ISD. The plan has been developed over three years. The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) requires the adoption of the plan before the final plan can be approved by Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA).

A motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham to adopt the plan. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Resolution and letter are attached.)

Order 1: Minutes from the May 14, 2018 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Brannon. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:

- a. Sheriff Morgan: presented the billing report for the month of April which is the best month of the year. As of today, there are 48 out of county inmates. Job openings are available.
- b. Commissioner Brannon: Work on the Dalby unit perimeter road continues. The State surplus road material has been released for use.
- c. Commissioner Morris: the landfill is being more stringent on the dumping of tires. He believes those tires may end up in the bar ditches in the county.

- d. Terry Bartlett with the GCHCD: all are invited to the open house today from 4-7 p.m. of the new ambulance facility.
 - e. Judge Norman: There is a meeting today concerning the Dalby unit lift station. Chita Odom thanked Precinct 4 on Facebook for the cleanup work after a recent storm. Rumors claim that the Lincoln Clean Energy wind power project may be on hold in Garza County. The preliminary construction has been ongoing since 2016 so that they can qualify for tax credits.

 - g. District Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (April)
- Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Williams to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Written reports are attached.)

Order 3: Came on for consideration was the precinct and countywide accounts payable for May 15, 2018 through May 24, 2018. Motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Brannon that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)

Order 5: Came on for consideration was line item corrections and budget amendment requests. None submitted.

Order 6: Public Comment
Sheriff Morgan thanked Melissa Flannigan for her ten years of service as a dispatcher. She will be attending DPS trooper school.

The meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m.

The next regular meeting is set for Monday, June 11, 2018.
