

A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, June 25, 2018 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct. 1-Jeff Williams, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct.3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Collector/Assessor. Also present: Tarlton Holloway, AgriLife Extension Agent; and Julia Childs, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the June 11, 2018 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Morris. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:
- a. Sheriff Morgan: there are 44 out-of-county inmates. Cochran County plans to enter into an inmate housing contract. The violence cell (rubber room) has been redone.
 - b. Tarleton Holloway, Ag Extension Agent: presented a monthly activity report. (Attached).
 - c. Judge Norman: Letter from the Department of Public Safety saying that the County is approved for a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan. Also, attended the TAC open house as the chairman of the unemployment board and attended a Department of Agriculture meeting as a representative of the board.
 - d. Tax Assessor-Collector
 - e. Justice of the Peace - 2
 - f. County Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (May)
 - g. District Court Monthly - Office of Court Administration (May)
- Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Williams to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Written reports are attached.)
- Order 3: Came on for consideration was the precinct and countywide accounts payable for June 11, 2018 through June 25, 2018. Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Benham that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer

for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)

- Order 4: Came on for consideration was whether to extend the burn ban (Order for Garza County Prohibition of Outdoor Burning). Motion was made by Commissioner Brannon seconded by Commissioner Benham to extend the burn ban for 90 days (ending October 9, 2018). With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Order is attached.)
- Order 5: Came on for consideration was a Tax Deed for lots 9, 10, 11 and 12 in block 12 of the Original Town of Post, Garza County, Texas. Tax Assessor-Collector Nancy Wallace explained that the City started seizure sales for code violations and does not include taxes. She is to hold a meeting to coordinate and to get a better understanding of the process. She explained that Attorney Weems believes this Deed is fine to approve. Motion was made by Commissioner Williams seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the tax deed as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Deed is attached.)
- Order 6: Came on for consideration was a Tax Deed for lots 13 and 14 in block 7 of the Original Town of Post, Garza County, Texas. Motion was made by Commissioner Williams seconded by Commissioner Benham to approve the tax deed as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Deed is attached.)
- Order 7: Came on for consideration was line item corrections and budget amendment requests. None presented.
- Order 8: Public Comment
July 4th celebration at the city park was discussed.
- Order 9: Budget Workshop
Judge Norman explained that the insurance cost figures just came in. Therefore, budget packets were not printed but will be available at the next meeting. Last year's certified values were \$510.3 million while the estimates for this year are \$492.8 million. The current tax rate is .5946. The new phone system will be covered from reserves in the current year's budget. A courthouse security system is in the works.


The meeting adjourned at 9:26 a.m.

The next regular meeting is set for Monday, July 9, 2018.




JEFF WILLIAMS, COMMISSIONER PCT. 1

TED BRANNON, COMMISSIONER PCT. 3



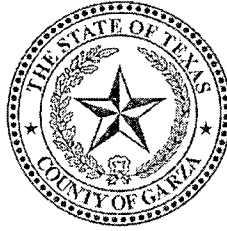
