

Local Disaster Declaration

WHEREAS, the County of Garza on the 16th of February, 2021, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from severe sub-zero temperatures resulting in the loss of electrical power and water to the citizens of Garza County. Citizens experienced extreme fuel bills, ranchers were out great expense for extra feed and wildlife was threatened due to the extreme cold

and

WHEREAS, the County Judge, Lee Norman of Garza County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF GARZA COUNTY:


That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Garza County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners' Court of Garza County.

Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.

Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Garza County Emergency Management Plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. ORDERED
this 16th day of February, 2021.
