

A Regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, January 8, 2024 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Order 3: Public Comment None presented.

Order 4: Minutes from the December 28, 2023 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Wilks. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 6: Reports from county offices-The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or verbal report:

Sheriff Morgan: Jail Inmate Count; 82, 31 are county inmates and 51 out of county. Garza County Billing for December 2023. See attachment.

Danya Peterson, Agri-Life Extension Agent: Garza County Junior Livestock Show will be Saturday, January 13, 2024. Sale will be Thursday, January 18, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. at the High School Commissary.

US Bank: Garza County Public Facility Corporation Taxable Project Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2012 from November 1, 2023 to November 30, 2023. See attachment. A motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Dalby to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.



- Order 7: Consider to approve revised Committee/Board Appointments for 2024. Meg Nelson and Tracy Cumby was appointed for the Lake Allen Henry Zoning Board. A motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Brannon to approve the appointments. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. - Order 8: Report of possible contamination in Justiceburg area. David Flake-Hartley addressed the court with concerns of water contamination on his property. He has filed a complaint with the Texas Railroad Commission concerning a nearby injection well. On July 21, 2023 an inspection of the lease was conducted and Well No. 2 must be repaired or plugged. Mr. Flake-Hartley received a letter on August 23, 2023 from the Texas Railroad Commission that a sampling of of his water well indicated an absence of oil field contamination and a passing H-5 mechanical integrity test on Well No. 2. Mr. Flake-Hartley said the water analysis indicated the presence of hydrocarbons which are hazardous to one's health. Mr. Flake-Hartley asks the court to take this matter seriously of oil field contamination for the health and safety of our community. Court will take Mr. Flake-Hartley's matter under advisement and contact legal counsel. See attachments. No action taken.
- Order 9: Budget Amendments and Line Item Transfers. A motion was made by Commissioner Dalby and seconded by Commissioner Wilks to approve the amendment to the budget receiving money from TJJD for GCJDC Grant in the amount of \$80,995.00 for December 2023. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
