Order 5: Reports from county offices-The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or verbal

report:

Sheriff Morgan: Jail Inmate Count;72, 21 are county inmates and 51 out of county. Will receive nine or ten inmates from Potter County tomorrow.

David Graves, Constable Pct. 1: Two more Septic Inspections next week.

Judge Norman: Next court meeting will be August 12, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. Received notice on July 30, 2024 stating Tarrant County will not be renewing contract with MTC. Working diligently to find new customers.
