

A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, January 14, 2019 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct.1-Jeff Williams, Pct.3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham. Not present was Pct. 2 Commissioner Charles Morris. County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Tarlton Holloway, AgriLife Extension Agent; Terry Bartlett, PEDC; Carla Sanchez, new clerk's office employee; Joseph and Ana Thompson; and Julia Child, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the December 27, 2018 regular meeting and the January 3, 2019 special meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Brannon and seconded by Commissioner Benham. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:
- a. Sheriff: Jail count is at 86. 45 are county inmates.  
Explained his report of what has happened calls over the last six year. And explained the jail billing report.

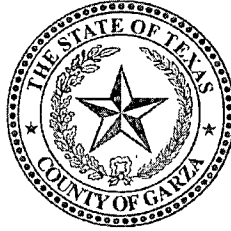
