A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, January 28, 2019 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct.1-Jeff Williams, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct.3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Ted Weems, Attorney; LuAnne Terry, Treasurer; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector.

Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Ginger Clemmons, Chief Deputy Clerk; Michael Isbell, Emergency Management Coordinator; Archie Gill, Mayor, City of Post; Stephanie Hataway, Owner, Buffalo Threads; Rodney Tidwell, Garza County Emergency Medical Service (EMS); and Julia Child, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Order 1: Minutes from the January 14, 2019 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Brannon. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.

Order 2: Reports from county offices - The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:

- a. Sheriff: The sheriff was ill, so Judge Norman read an E-mail from him stating that there are 87 inmates, 35 are Garza County's and 52 are from out of county. He noted that there are three employees that have been with Garza County 10 Years: Michael Copeland, Becky Beggs and Michelle Ramirez.
- b. Michael Isbell: Is meeting with TxDoT to help with getting some help from engineers with road maintenance.
- c. Clerk

Motion was made by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Williams to accept the reports as presented. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Written reports are attached.)

Order 3: Came on for consideration was the precinct and countywide accounts payable for January 15, 2019 through January 28, 2019.

Motion was made by Commissioner Morris and seconded by Commissioner Brannon that all accounts presented in the fund requirement print-out is ordered paid and presented to the Treasurer for payment. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Printout is attached.)

- Order 4: Came on for consideration was a resolution for heart health month. Stephanie Hataway, Rodney Tidwell and Julia Childs spoke about Heart Health Month events in February. Information is attached. Motion was made by Commissioner Williams seconded by Commissioner Morris to approve the resolution for heart health month. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. (Resolution is attached.)
- Order 5: Came on for consideration was the sale of fireworks for the Texas Independence Day period. The item died for lack of a motion, therefore not permitting the sale of fireworks during the period. Information is attached.
- Order 6: Came on for consideration was line item corrections and budget amendment requests. No line item corrections and No budget amendments were submitted.
- Order 7: Public Comment
Judge Norman thanked City of Post Mayor Archie Gill for his attendance and for his years of service serving as mayor. The Post Dispatch recently reported that he will not seek reelection.


The meeting adjourned at 9:19 a.m.
