Lee Norman - Garza County Judge

A regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, February 11, 2019 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Main St., Post, Texas with the following members present: Lee Norman, Judge; Commissioners, Pct.1-Jeff Williams, Pct. 2-Charles Morris, Pct.3-Ted Brannon and Pct. 4-Jerry Benham.

County officials present: Jim Plummer, District and County Clerk; Ted Weems, Attorney; Terry Morgan, Sheriff; and Nancy Wallace, Tax Assessor/Collector. Also present: Meg Nelson, Administrative Assistant; Christie Tadlock, Deputy Treasurer; Michael Isbell, Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC); Terry Bartlett, Post Economic Development Corporation (PEDC); and Julia Childs, Post Dispatch.

Judge Norman called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

- Order 1: Minutes from the January 28, 2019 regular meeting were approved as presented with a motion by Commissioner Benham and seconded by Commissioner Brannon. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 2: Reports from county offices The following items of information were brought before the Court as a written and/or a verbal report:
  - a. Sheriff: Jail count is at 89 with 39 being county inmates. Explained the month of jail billing for January was up compared to recent months and reviewed emergency call statistics.
