Also present: Carol Williams, Administrative Assistant; Danya Peterson, AgriLife Extension Agent; 4-H students Elizabeth Payton, Trea Peterson, Sylee Peterson, Brailey Nelson, Rylie Tabor, Kelson Lee, and Kalli J. Davis; 4-H parent supporters J.W. Payton, Tom Payton, Cristi Lee and Larry Lee; and Terry Bartlett, Post Economic Development Corporation (PEDC).
