# STATISTICAL DATA FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015

In presenting this budget to the Commissioners' Court of Garza County and to the taxpayers of Garza County, Texas, the following statistics are set out.

The proposed budget was submitted in Commissioners' Court on Thursday, September 18, 2014. A motion was made by Commissioner Precinct #1, Gary McDaniel, that the budget be adopted as presented. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Precinct #2, Charles Morris. The budget was approved unanimously as attached.

### TAX INFORMATION

ESTIMATED TOTAL COLLECTIBLE VALUATION———937,250,798

The assessed valuation above shows a increase of \_\_19,402,113\_\_\_\_\_ from that of the preceding year.

Total assessed valuation in Garza County for 2014 is based on 100% of the true market value of property assessed.

The 2014 Effective Tax Rate is .389626 and the 2014 Rollback Rate is .420796. The adopted rate of .41900 is .029374 above the effective rate, or .001796 below the rollback rate. The adopted tax rate of .41900 is a 5.01% increase over last year's tax rate of .39900%.

Commissioners Court met Thursday, September 18, 2014 to adopt a tax rate of .41900 for the fiscal 2014-2015 budget to fund Maintenance and Operations. Commissioner Charles Morris, Precinct #2 moved that the .41900 rate be accepted; it was seconded by Commissioner Ted Brannon, Precinct #3. The vote was unanimous.

The total county levy for M&O, based on the rate of .41900, is \$3,927080.84. Of the total county collectible levy, 85% (\$3,338,018.72) is allocated to the General Fund and 15% (\$589,062.13) to Special Road and Bridge Funds. Special Road and Bridge Funds are divided as follows to be used for the maintenance and repair to 250 miles of county maintained roads:

### LONG TERM DEBT:

In 2009 Garza County, Texas issued \$9,240,000 Combination Tax And Revenue Certificates of Obligation, Series 2008. The Certificates are general obligations of the County, payable from an annual ad valorem tax levied against all taxable property in the County, within the limits prescribed by law, and further secured by a pledge of net revenues derived from the operation of a 96-bed jail facility.

Outstanding Principal as of October 1, 2014 is \$ 7,6000,000.00
